<b>944:</b> <b>Externships</b> (2/3/4 cr) <i>Beem</i>	To be enrolled in the externship course, students must apply through the Office of Professional Development and be approved by Assistant Dean Beem. Students are unable to enroll in the course via myCap. Students may seek 2, 3 or 4 credits of externship during the summer semester. This course does not meet for a regular weekly class session.
